

FICPI - Resolutions passed at Kyoto ExCo 2014

Four FICPI Resolutions were finalized, voted on, and approved during the Executive Committee (“ExCo”) meeting held in Kyoto. The four resolutions are:

- Mailbox Patents
- Sequence Listing
- Protection of Geographical Indications for non-food products in the European Union (EU)
- Industrial applicability requirement in pharmaceutical patents

As part of FIPCI’s mandate to assist IP practitioners in private practice, FICPI undertakes topics to study and upon completion of the study prepares draft Resolutions. The drafts are discussed, finalized, and voted on at ExCo meetings. If approved by a majority of the Delegates to the ExCo, the Resolution is published presented to the appropriate authorities around the world.
